#### **REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE**

During the month of February 2012, imports to Barbados were valued at \$298.9 million whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$124.5 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$174.4 million, compared with a visible trade deficit of \$202.9 million for February 2011.

Imports for February 2012 were \$21.8 million more than imports recorded for February 2011, an increase of 7.9%. Total exports also increased in value by some \$50.4 million, or 68.0% of the February 2011 figure. This was as a result of increases recorded in domestic exports of \$19.4 million, or 52.0%, and in the value of re-exports of \$31.0 million, or 84.1%, in comparison with the corresponding month in 2011.

For the period January – February 2012, the value of imports to Barbados was \$555.3 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$220.4 million. This resulted in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$334.9 million as compared to a similar deficit of \$342.2 million for January - February 2011.

Imports for January - February 2012 were \$55.3 million more than imports for the corresponding period in 2011, an increase of 11.1%. Total exports also increased in value by some \$62.6 million, or 39.7%, over the January - February 2011 figure. This was as a result of increases recorded in domestic exports of \$22.2 million, or 27.4%, and in the value of re-exports of \$40.4 million, or 52.7%, in comparison with the corresponding period in 2011.

#### **CARICOM TRADE**

During the month of February 2012, imports from CARICOM countries were valued at \$128.1 million whilst total exports to CARICOM countries were valued at \$21.6 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$106.5 million, compared with a visible trade deficit of \$88.4 million for February 2011.

CARICOM imports for February 2012 were \$20.0 million more than CARICOM imports for February 2011, an increase of 18.5%. Total exports to CARICOM countries for February 2012 also increased in value by \$1.8 million, or 9.3%, of the total exports figure for February 2011. This increase in exports came as a result of an increase recorded in reexports of \$2.3 million, or 64.7%, while the value of domestic exports declined by \$0.4 million, or 2.8%, in comparison with the corresponding month in 2011.

For the period January – February 2012, total imports from CARICOM countries were valued at \$220.9 million whilst total exports to CARICOM countries were valued at \$50.1 million. This resulted in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$170.8 million, compared with a deficit of \$131.8 million for the period January – February 2011.

During this period, CARICOM imports were approximately \$41.8 million more than those recorded over the same period in 2011, an increase of 23.4%. Total exports to CARICOM countries for January – February 2012 also increased in value by \$2.8 million, or 5.9%, of the total exports figure for the corresponding period in 2011. This increase in exports came as a result of increases recorded in domestic exports of \$1.8 million, or 4.6%, and in the value of re-exports of \$1.0 million, or 12.5%, in comparison with the corresponding period in 2011.

#### **REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE**

During the month of February 2012 imports to Barbados were valued at \$298.7 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$124.5 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$174.1 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$203.2 million for February 2011.

Imports for February 2012 were \$21.3 million less than imports for February 2011 a decrease of 7.7%. Total exports increased in value by some \$50.4 million or 68.0% of the February 2011 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$19.4 million or 52.0% over February 2011. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$31.0 million or 84.1% for the corresponding month 2011.

For the period January - February 2012, the value of imports to Barbados was \$564.8 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$220.4 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$334.4 million as compared to a similar deficit of \$342.5 million for January - February 2011.

Imports for January - February 2012 were \$54.6 million more than imports for the same period 2011, a decrease of 10.9%. Total exports showed an increase of \$62.6 million or 39.7% over the January - February 2011 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$22.2 million or 27.4% over January - February 2011. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$40.4 million or 52.7% over the corresponding period 1

#### **CARICOM TRADE**

During the month of February 2012 imports from Caricom countries were valued at \$128.1 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$21.6 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$106.5 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$88.4 million for February 2011.

Caricom imports for February 2012 were \$20.0 million less than Caricom imports for February 2011, a decrease of 18.5%. Total exports to Caricom for February 2012 were \$1.8 million more than total exports for February 2011 an increase of 9.3%. Domestic exports increased by \$0.4 million or 2.8% over the corresponding month 2011. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$2.3 million or 64.7% of the February 2011 figure.

For the period January - February 2012 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$220.9 million whilst total exports were \$50.1 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$170.8 million as compared with a deficit of 131.8 million for the same period of 2011.


During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$41.8 million more than those for January - February 2011, a decrease of 23.4%. Total exports to Caricom for January - February 2012 were \$2.8 million more than total exports for the corresponding period 2011, an increase of 5.9%. Domestic exports increased by \$1.8 million or 4.6% over the same period 2010. The value of re-exports also decreased by some \$1.0 million or 12.5% over the January - February 2011 figure.


