The Retail Price Index for May 2017 increased by $0.9 \%$ in comparison to April 2017, moving from 172.0 to 173.5 index points.

Please note revisions have been made to April 2016 through to April 2017 due to a processing error in the Education group; these revisions can be seen in Table 1; Table 2; Table 7a; and the All Items Index graph.

Amongst the major groups: Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 5.2 points or 2.4\%.

Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics remained unchanged.

Clothing and Footwear increased by 0.1 of a point or $0.1 \%$.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels increased by 0.2 of a point or 0.1\%.

Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance increased by 1.2 points or $0.8 \%$.

Health increased by 3.0 points or $1.5 \%$.

Transport decreased by 0.6 of a point or $0.4 \%$.

Communication remained unchanged.

Recreation and Culture decreased by 0.7 of a point or $0.7 \%$.

Education decreased by 17.4 points or $3.8 \%$.

Restaurants and Hotels increased by 0.5 of a point or $0.2 \%$.

Miscellaneous Goods and Services decreased by 1.0 points or 0.9\%.
