





## **Stay-Over Visitors and Cruise Ship Passenger Arrivals**

March 2016 saw positive growth in visitor arrivals. Among stay-over visitors, arrivals increased by **3,216** tourists (or **5.6%**) to **60,601** compared to **57,385** in the year 2015. Total cruise arrivals decreased by **6.7%** over the review period to **84,337** passengers.





An increase was observed among stay-over arrivals from Trinidad & Tobago (\*)50.8%)

Germany stay-over visitors decreased to 1,637 (♣11.5%)

Other CARICOM arrivals increased to 4,935 (**↑11.1%**)

Visitor arrivals from Other Countries totalled 2,205 (♠6.5%)

#### **Cruise**


Intransit cruise passengers numbered 62,750 (**♣11.1%**)


Landed passengers grew to 21,587(**↑9.3**%)

The number of cruise calls totalled 57 (♣3.4%)

# **Other Highlights:**

Among the **60,601** stay-over arrivals recorded for this period, **51,172** (or 84.4%) visited for recreational purposes, predominantly for holiday (**47,059** tourists). This represents an increase of **5.9%** among all recreational visitors. The average number of days spent in Barbados among stay-over visitor arrivals was approximately **9.7** days over the review period.





Visits for study increased to 370 (**↑37.0%**)

Health care visits totalled 133(**₹24.9**%)

Sports visit increased to 1,041 (**↑24.4**%)

Visits for the purpose of visiting friends rose to 2,177 (★20.3%)

Other recreation arrivals increased to 560 (13.4%)

Honeymoon/getting married visits totalled 335 (**↑8.1%**)


#### Length of stay


Visits for 22-28 days totalled 602 (**♣18.6**%)

Average length of stay was 9.68 days (**♣0.1%**)

## **YEAR TO DATE**

January - March 2016 saw positive growth in visitor arrivals. Among stay-over visitors, arrivals increased by **6,299** tourists (or **5.9%**) to **113,896** compared to **107,597** in the year 2015 (**Figure 5**). Total cruise arrivals increased by **15.9%** over the review period to **335,156** passengers.





Trinidad & Tobago stay-over visitors rose to 7,210 (★34.1%)

Tourist arrivals from U.S.A totalled 42,230 (**12.8%**)

An increase was observed among stay-over arrivals from the U.K (19.9%)

Tourists arrivals from Germany to 4,837 (₹7.2%)

#### **Cruise**


Intransit cruise passengers numbered 255,012 (★17.4%)


Landed passengers rose to 80,144 (**↑11.4**%)

The number of cruise calls totalled 199 (19.3%)

## **Other Highlights:**

Among the **183,908** stay-over arrivals recorded for this period, **153,789** (or 83.6%) visited for recreational purposes, predominantly for holiday (**143,141** tourists). This represents an increase of **7.9%** among all recreational visitors. The average number of days spent in Barbados among stay-over visitor arrivals was approximately **11.1** days over the review period.





Intransit arrivals totalled 3,120 (**♣69.1%**)

Business/ Conference increase to 22,574(**↑59.6%**)

Honeymoon/getting married totalled 999 (**16.7%**)

Visits for the purpose of visiting friends increased to 6,222 (**13.4%**)

Other recreational visits increased to 1,740 (\*13.1%)

Other purposes of visit totalled to 2,326(**♣10.5%**)

## **Length of stay**

Visits of 4-7 days totalled 62,310 (**11.4%**)

Average length of stay was 11.1 days (**♣1.7%**)




