


Births and Deaths Report Q2 2020



Quarter two of 2020 recorded a contraction of **35.2 percent** in births from **645** in 2019 to **418**. Owing to the fact that both males and females recorded decreases in the number of births, **38.3 percent** and **31.8 percent** respectively.

The number of registered deaths showed a decline of **11.1 percent** for the period under review. The number of male deaths recorded a contraction. The average age of death during the period was **72.8** years



Registered Deaths by Sex



In the second quarter in 2020, there were **212** female registered births, **6** more than that of males **(206)**; conversely, in the same quarter of 2019, **334** males were registered when compared to the **311** females.

Registered deaths in the period under review for 2020 were reported as follows: males – **339** and females – **327**. Males declined by **12.2 percent**, and the number of females contracted by **9.9 percent**, with regards to deaths in the second quarter of 2019.

The average age of a mother giving birth was **28.9** years, with **48.8 percent (204)** of the births coming from mothers in the 20-29 age group.

The number of births from mothers in the 40-49 age group dropped to **25**.

For the period April to June 2020, the youngest mother was **17 years**, followed by **ten 18 year olds**, while the oldest mother registered was **47 years**, which stood at **50**, one year before. However, in 2019, the youngest mother was **13 years**.

The youngest father was also recorded at **17 years**, followed by one at **18**, while the oldest was **59 years** during the second quarter of 2020. For 2019, the oldest father was **67 years old**, while the youngest was **15 years old**.






A contraction was noted in the number of single babies registered in the period under review, moving from **626** in 2019 to **410**.

The number of twins declined in 2020 to **8** from **19** in the second quarter of 2019.

No triplets were born in the period under review in 2020.

Quarter 2 of 2020 saw decreases in births from all eleven of the parishes.

The number of babies from St. Michael fell to **148** (**31.8 percent**), and it still remained the parish with the highest number of births.

The number of babies for the quarter under review born in St. Lucy fell by **12** or by **57.1 percent**.

St. Philip babies contracted to **48** (**25 percent**).

The least number of babies were recorded from St. Andrew – **8**, followed by St. Joseph with **9**.



There were **2** still-borns recorded in the second quarter of 2020 when compared to the **lone** still birth in 2019.



A contraction of **11.1 percent** was observed in the number of deaths recorded for the period under review.

The average age of death during the period was **72.8** years.

All but one age-group **(60-69 years)** registered contractions in the number of deceased persons; the largest was in the **80-89 years** age group, followed by the **50-59** age group and then the **90-99**.

In April to June 2020, the larger number of deaths was attributed to males – **339**, when compared to **327** females; whereas in the same period for 2019, **386** males passed away, along with **363** females.

With regards to marital status in 2020, single persons accounted for **42.0 percent** of all deaths, followed by married which stood at **22.5 percent**.

St. Michael, had the largest number of registered deaths – **248** for Q2 of 2020 and **254** for 2019. However, the least number of deaths were recorded in both 2020 and 2019 was in **St. Andrew – 7**.
