Q2 2021**

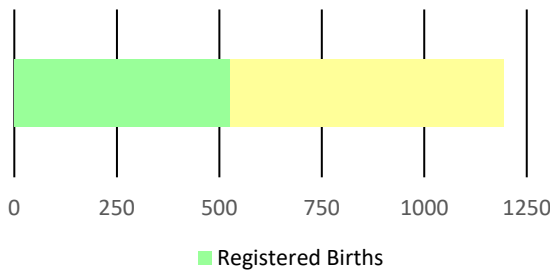

An expansion of **26.1 percent** was registered in the second quarter of 2021, as a result of increases in both the number of births for males and females, **26.2 percent** and **25.9 percent**, respectively.

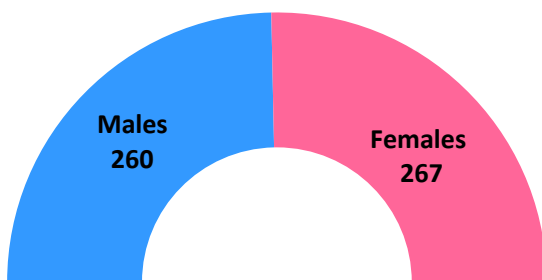
The number of registered deaths showed a small decline of **1.5 percent** for the period under review. The number of female deaths recorded a contraction (**4.3 percent**), while male registered deaths rose albeit slightly by **1.2 percent**.

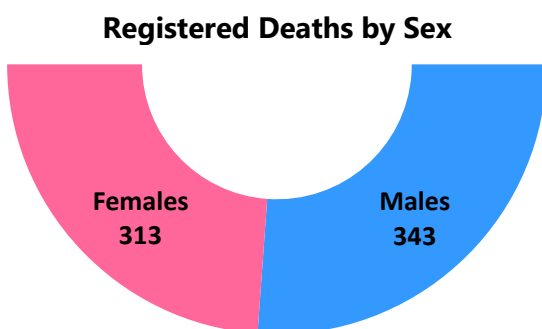

For the second quarter in 2021, there were **267** female registered births, **7** more than that of males (**260**). In the same quarter of 2020, **206** males were registered when compared to the **212** females.

Registered deaths in the period under review for 2021 were reported as follows: males – **343** and females – **313**. Males rose by **1.2 percent**, and the number of females contracted by **4.3 percent**, with regards to deaths in the second quarter of 2020.

The average age of a mother giving birth was **28.9** years, with **44.6 percent (235)** of the births coming from mothers in the 20-29 age group, closely followed by the 30-39 age group (**234**).

The number of births from mothers in the 40-49 age group dropped to **23**.

For the period April to June 2021, the youngest mother was **12 years**, followed by **one 15 year old**, while the oldest mother registered was **48 years**, which stood at **47**, one year before. However, in 2020, the youngest mother was five years older at **17 years**.

The two youngest fathers were recorded at **18 years**, while the oldest was **59 years** during the second quarter of 2021. For 2020, the oldest father was also **59 years old**, while the youngest was **17 years old**.

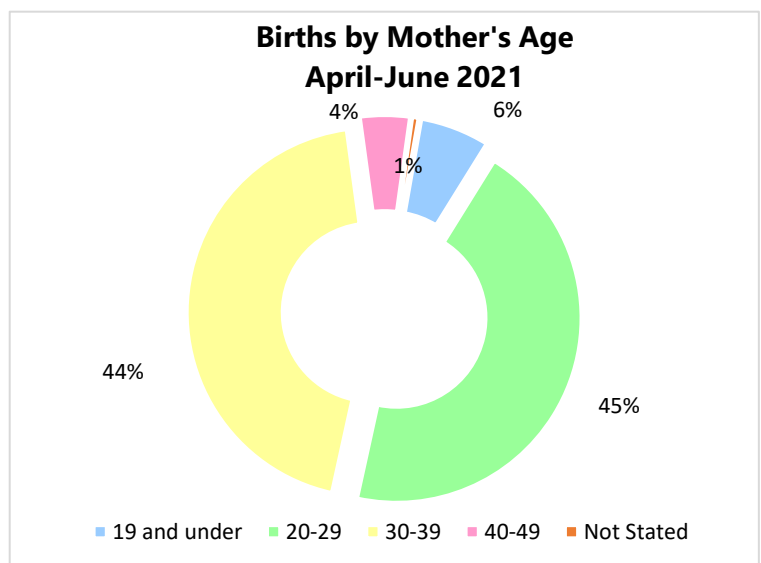

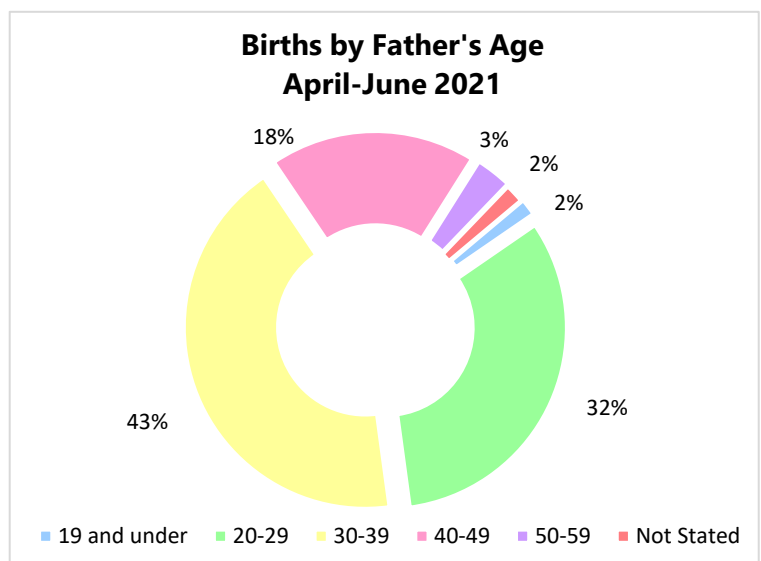
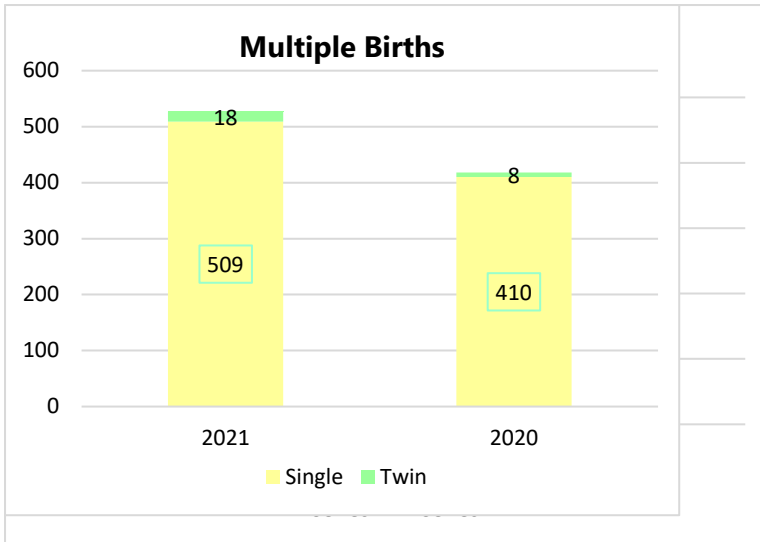

An expansion was noted in the number of single babies registered in the period under review, moving from **410** in 2020 to **509**.

The number of twins also increased in 2021 to **18** from **8** in the second quarter of 2020.

No triplets were born in the period under review in 2021 or 2020.

Quarter 2 of 2021 saw decreases in births from two of the eleven of the parishes, St. John (**5.3 percent**) and St. Peter (**6.3 percent**).

The number of babies from St. Michael rose to **175 (18.2 percent)**. St. Andrew had the highest change in the number of babies registered (**112.5 percent**).

Significant expansions in the number of babies registered were recorded in St. Lucy (**66.7 percent**), St. James (**50.0 percent**), Christ Church (**33.8 percent**) and St. George (**31.0 percent**).

The least number of babies were recorded from St. Joseph with **11**.

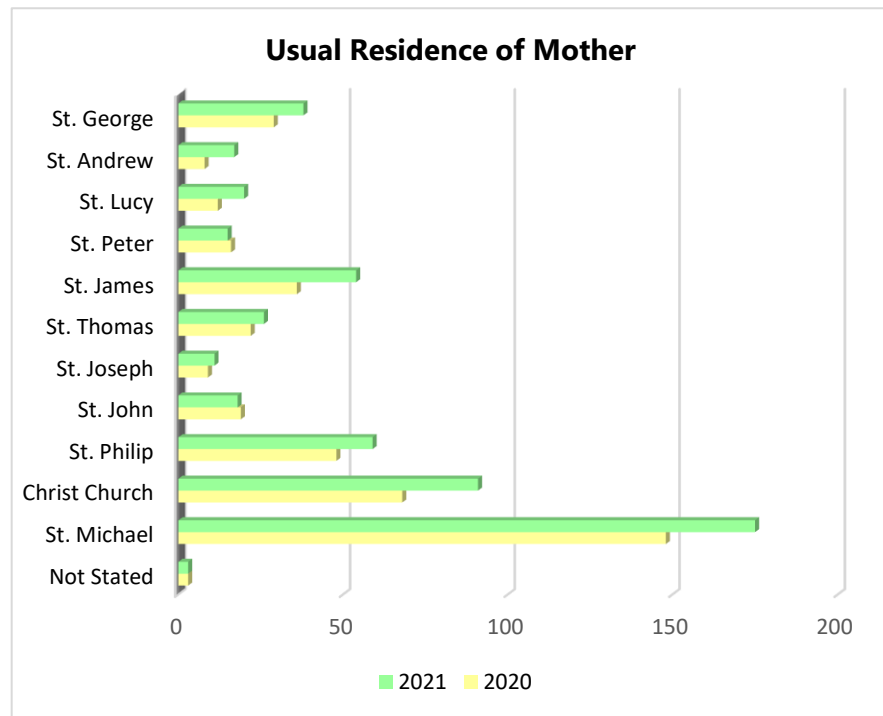

There were **0** still-borns recorded in the second quarter of 2021 when compared to the **2** still births in 2020.

A contraction of **1.5 percent** was observed in the number of deaths recorded for the period under review.

The average age of death during the period was **73.1** years.

In April to June 2021, the larger number of deaths was attributed to males – **343**, when compared to **313 females**; whereas in the same period for 2020, **339** males passed away, along with **327**.

The age group with the largest number of registered births was the **80-89 (158)**, followed by the **70-79 (147)**.

The oldest person passing away in the review period was **107 years**.

With regards to marital status in 2021, single persons accounted for **44.4 percent** of all deaths, followed by married which stood at **24.5 percent**.

St. Michael, had the largest number of registered deaths – **222** for quarter two of 2021 and **248** for 2020. However, the least number of deaths were recorded in 2021 and 2020 **St. Joseph (16)** and **St. Andrew (7)**, respectively.

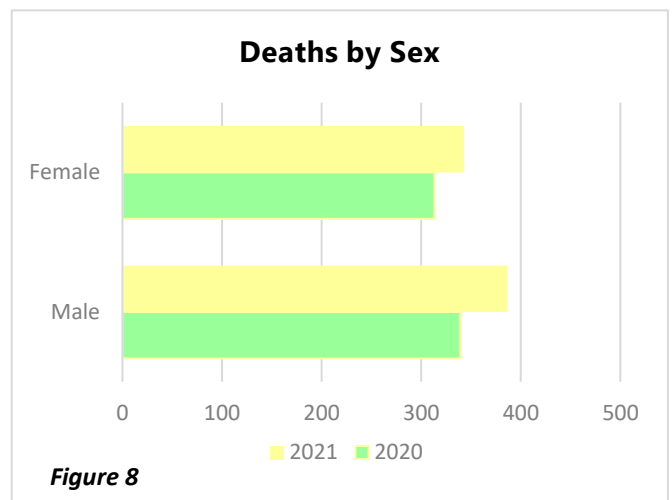

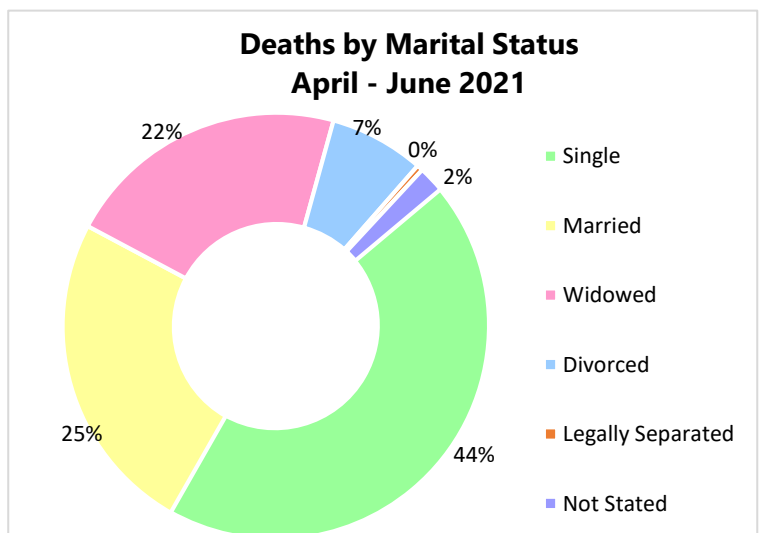
