## FEBRUARY 2023

(Base: July 2018=100)

The Retail Price Index for February 2023 increased by 1.0\% over January 2023, moving from 110.4 to 111.5 index points.

Amongst the divisions: Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 0.5 of a point or 0.4\%.

Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics decreased by 0.7 of a point or $0.7 \%$.

Clothing and Footwear increased by 1.6 points or $1.7 \%$.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels decreased by 0.5 of a point or $0.4 \%$.

Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance increased by 0.5 points or $0.4 \%$.

Health increased by 2.3 points or $2.0 \%$.

Transport increased by 2.8 points or $2.4 \%$.

Communication decreased by 0.3 of a point or $0.3 \%$.

Recreation and Culture increased by 3.2 points or $2.9 \%$.

Education decreased by 0.8 of a point or $0.9 \%$.

Restaurants and Hotels increased by 1.8 points or $1.4 \%$.

Miscellaneous Goods and Services increased by 4.6 points or 4.4\%.
