Q1 2000**

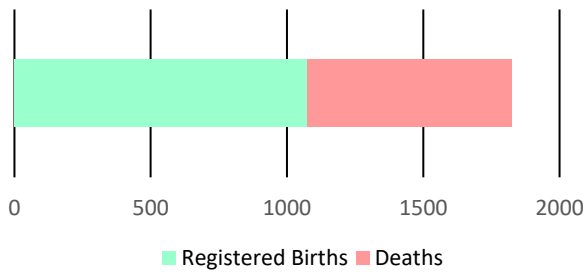


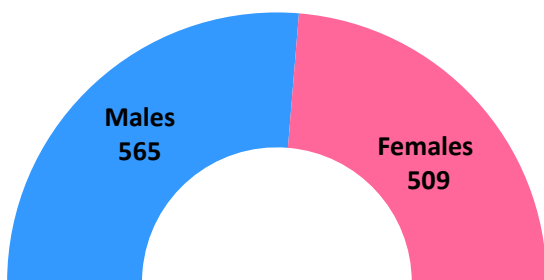

The first quarter of 2000 recorded a total of **1,074** births, where there were **565** males and **509** females.

With regards to the number of registered deaths, **404** were males and **345** were females. The total number of deaths were **749**.

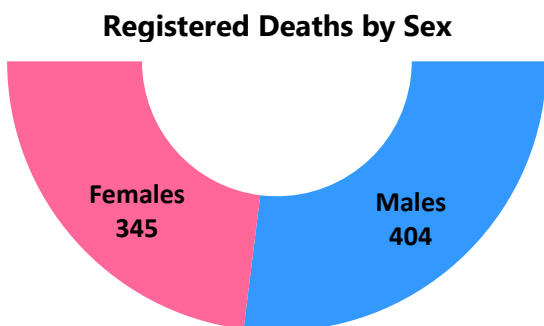

For the first quarter in 2000, female registered births - **509** were less than those of males - **565**.

Registered deaths in the period under review for 2000 were reported that females also were less than males with **345** and **404** respectively.

The average age of a mother giving birth was **26.9 years**, with **50.3 percent (540)** of the births coming from mothers in the 20-29 age group.

The number of births from mothers in the 40-49 age group was **30**.

For the period January to March 2000, the youngest mother was **one 14 year old**, followed by **four 15 year olds**, while the oldest mother registered was **44 years**.

On the other hand, there were **two 16 year olds**, who were logged as the youngest fathers for the period in 2000; conversely, the oldest was **58 years**.

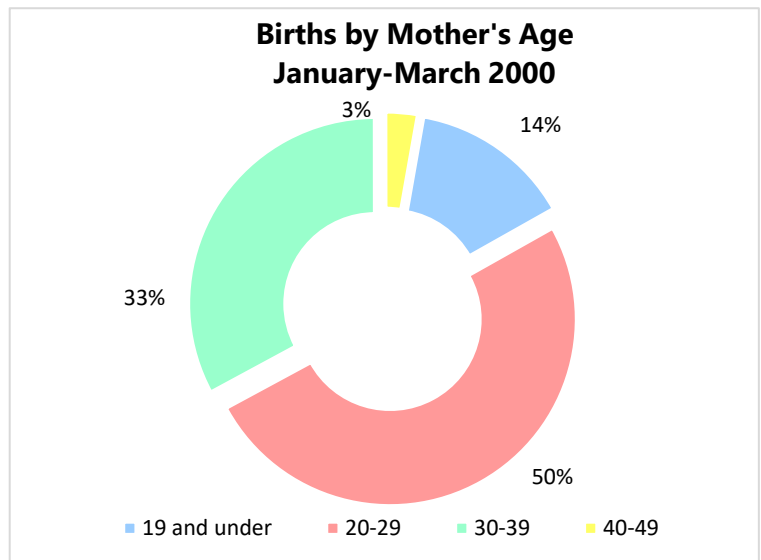

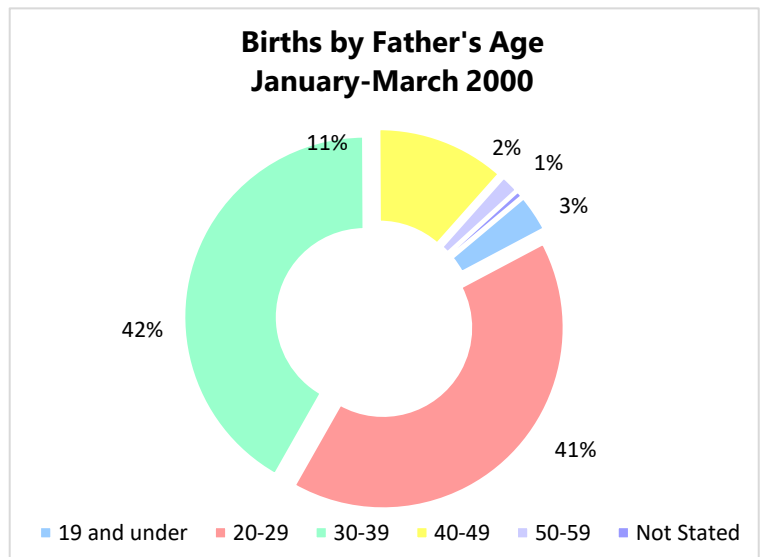

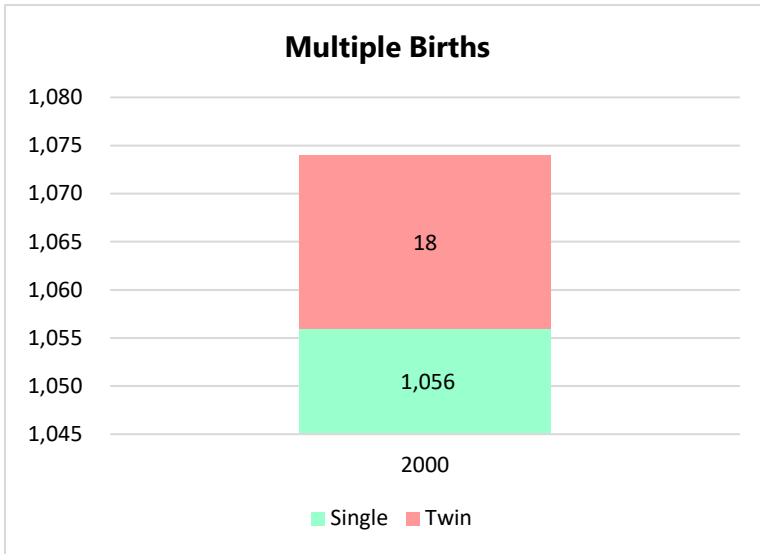

The number of single babies registered were **1,056**.

There were **no triplets** registered in the period under review of the first quarter of 2000.

There were **nine (9)** sets of twins recorded for quarter 1 of 2000.

Quarter 1 of 2000 saw the highest registered births from the parish of **St. Michael – 398**.

The number of babies from **Christ Church** came second highest with **194 (18.1 percent)**.

Babies from St. Andrew were counted at **23**.

The smallest number of babies for the quarter under review were born in **St. Joseph** were the least number recorded - **21**.

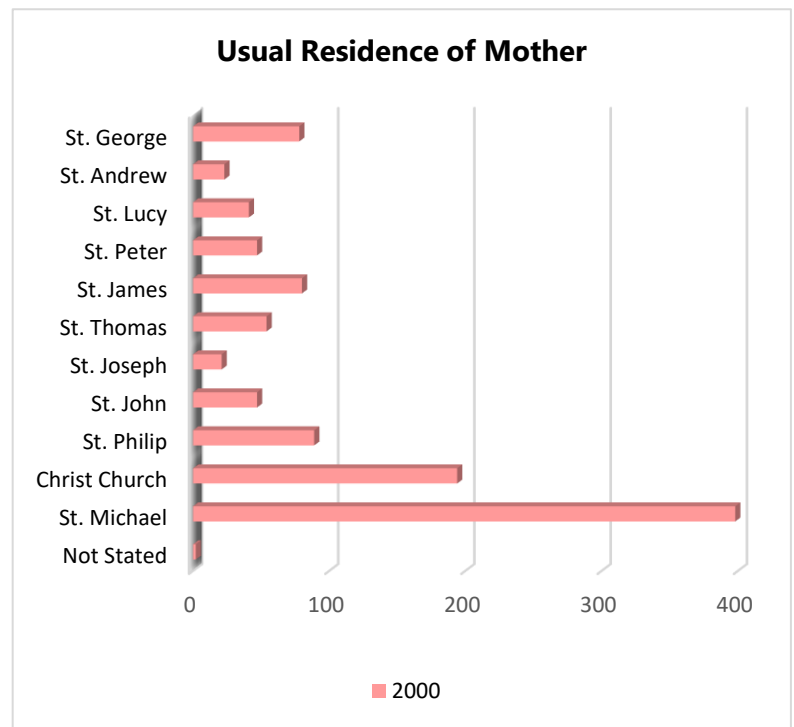

There were **0** still-borns recorded in the first quarter of 2000.

The average age of death during the period was **68.8 years**.

The largest number of registered deaths was in the **80-89 age group (26.2 percent)**, followed by the **70-79 age group (21 percent)** and then the **90-99 (12 percent)**.

In January to March 2000, the larger number of deaths was attributed to males – **404** as opposed to **345** females.

With regards to marital status, single persons accounted for **259 (34.6 percent)** of all deaths, followed by married which stood at **222 (29.6 percent)**.

St. Michael had the largest number of registered births - **305** for the first three months of 2000. However, the least number of deaths were recorded was in **St. Andrew – 14**.

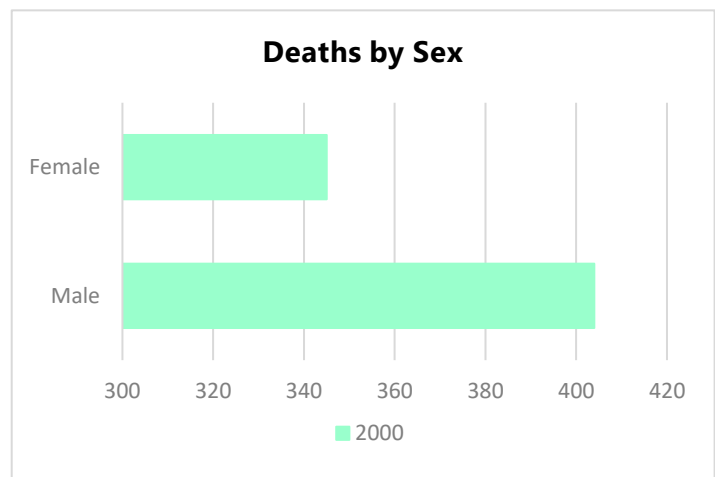

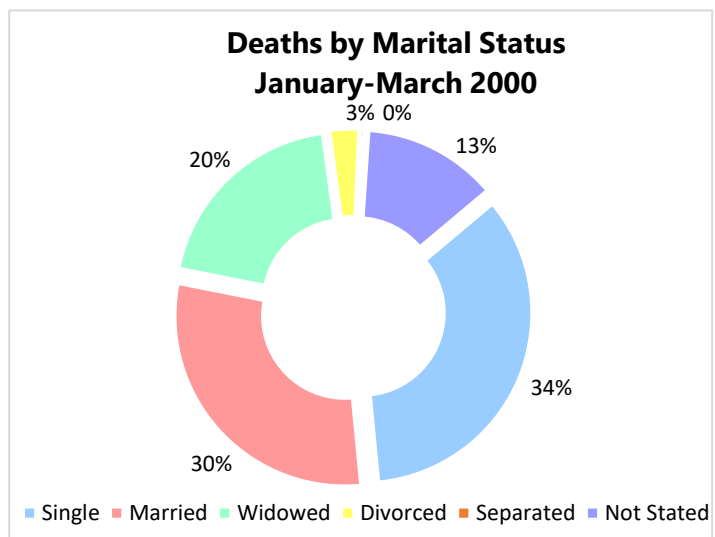
