Q2 2000**

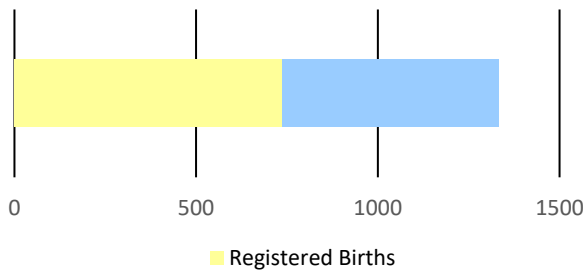

Quarter two of 2000 recorded a total of **736** births. The males represented **53 percent** and the females represented **47 percent**.

The number of registered deaths for the period under review were **595**. **52.9 percent** of the deaths were male, while the remaining amount were female (**47.1 percent**)

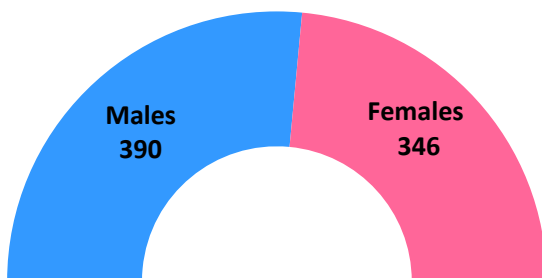

Registered Deaths by Sex

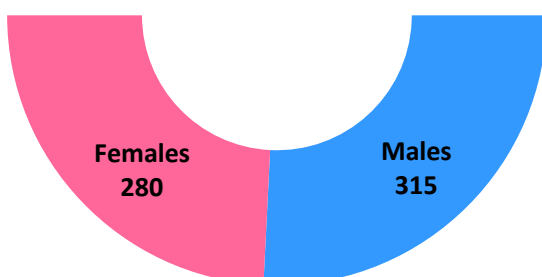

Registered deaths in the period under review for 2000 were reported as follows: males – **315** and females – **280**.

The average age of a mother giving birth was **25.4 years**, with **45.4 percent (334)** of the births coming from mothers in the **20-29** age group.

The number of births from mothers in the **40-49** age group recorded **20**.

For the period April to June 2000, the youngest mothers were **four 14 year olds**, followed by **eight 15 year olds**, while the oldest mother registered was **43 years**.

The youngest father was recorded at **15 years**, followed by **two** at **16 years**, while the oldest was **58 years** during the second quarter of 2000.

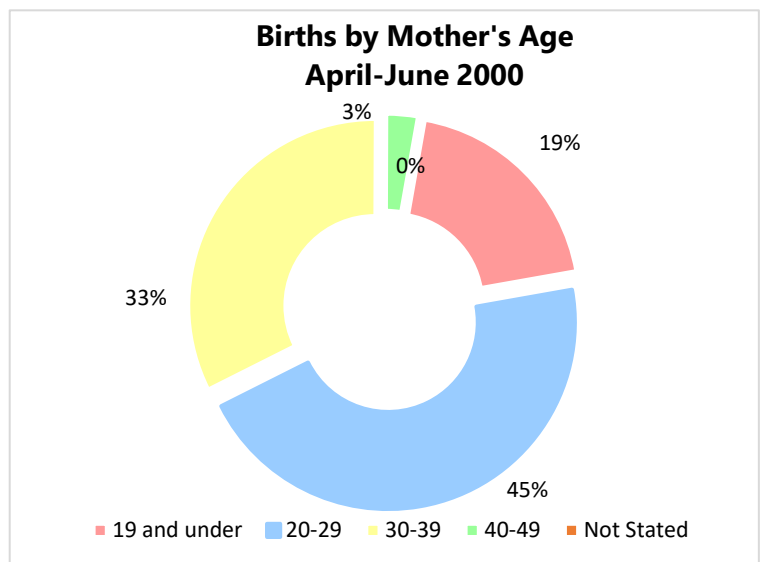

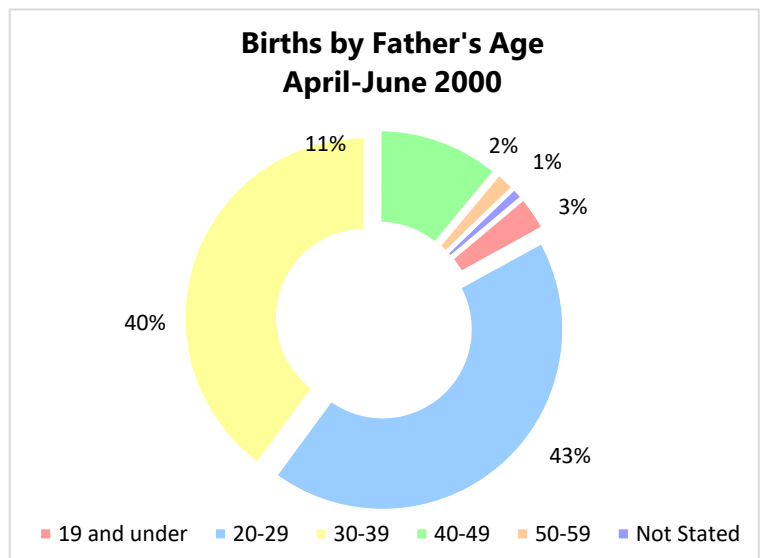
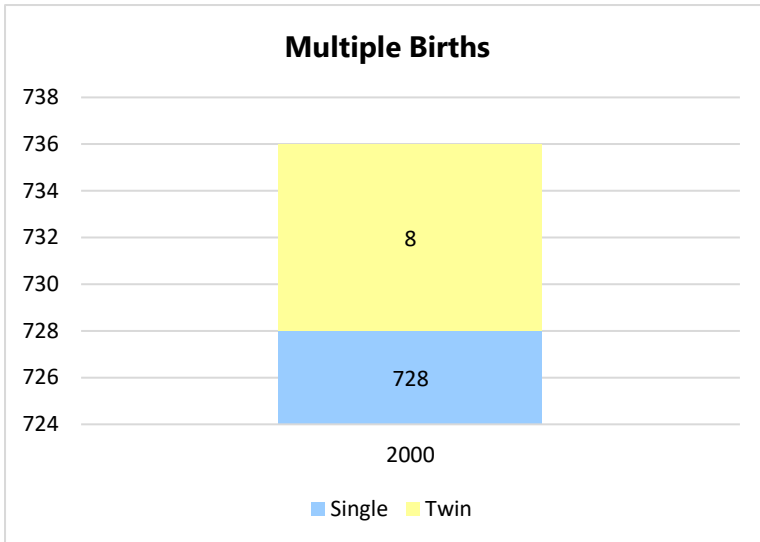

There were **four (4)** sets of twins recorded for the period under review.

No triplets were registered.

The number of babies from **St. Michael** fell to **287 (39 percent)**, and it remained the parish with the highest number of births.

The number of babies for the quarter under review born in **St. Lucy** was **28** or **3.8 percent**.

St. Philip babies were recorded at **52**, (**7.1 percent**).

The least number of babies was noted in **St. Andrew – 8**.

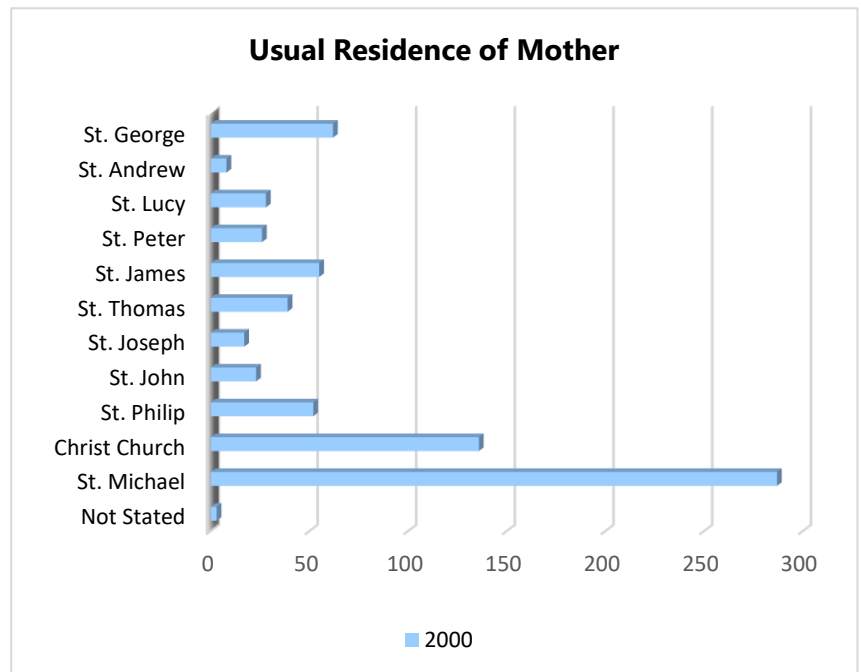

The average age of death during the period was **69.8** years.

The largest number of deaths was in the **80-89 years** age group (**26.1 percent**), followed by the **70-79** age group with **21.7 percent**.

In April to June 2000, the larger number of deaths was attributed to males – **315**, when compared to **280** females.

With regards to marital status in 2000, single persons accounted for **35.5 percent** of all deaths, followed by married which stood at **32.9 percent**.

St. Michael had the largest number of registered deaths – **240** However, the least number of deaths was recorded in **St. Andrew** – **13**.

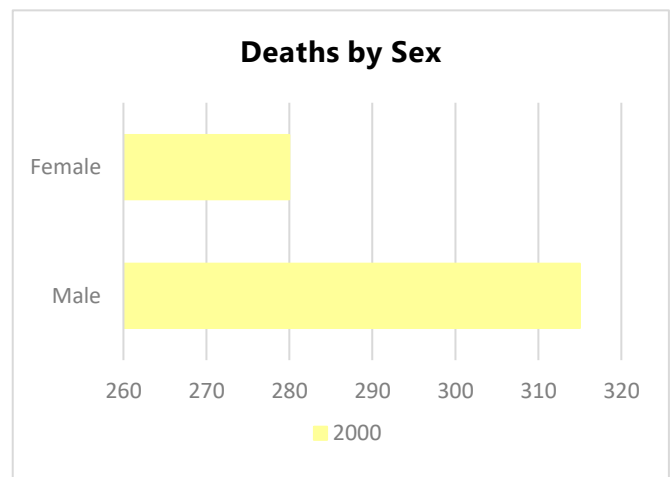

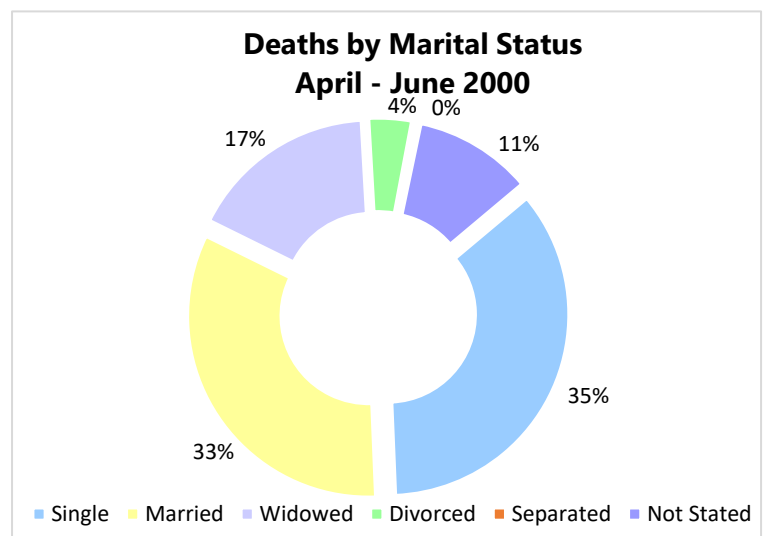
