Q2 2001**

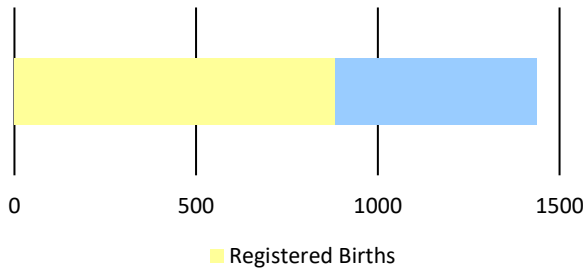

For the second quarter of 2001, **883** births were recorded, of which females and males represented **46.1 percent** and **53.9 percent** respectively.

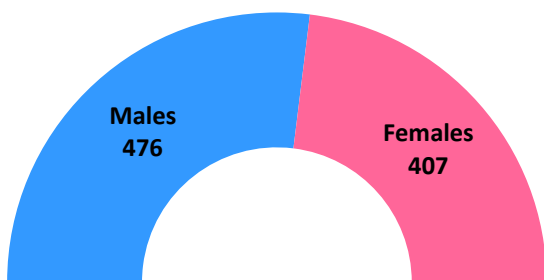
The number of registered deaths that the larger portion of deaths came from males – **52.0 percent** when compared to females – **48.0 percent** of the total death in quarter 2 of 2001 – **556**.

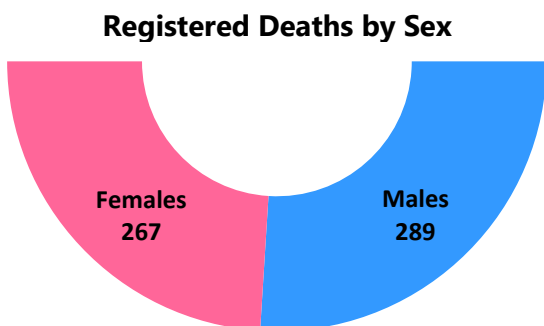

The second quarter of 2001 produced **407** female registered births, **69** less than that of the **476** male births.

Registered deaths in the period under review for 2001 were reported as follows: males – **289** and females – **267**.

The average ages of a mother and father was **26.6** and **30.9** years respectively, with **49.2 percent (434)** of the births coming from mothers and **43.0 percent (317)** to fathers in the 20-29 age group.

The number of births from mothers in the 40-49 age group were **30**. Fathers in the same age group were recorded as **106** in 2001.

For the period April to June 2001, the youngest mother was **12 years**, followed by **three 14 year olds**, while the oldest mother registered was **53 years**, which stood at **43**, one year before.

The youngest father was also recorded at **16 years**, followed by **five at 17**, while the oldest was **59 years** during the second quarter of 2001.

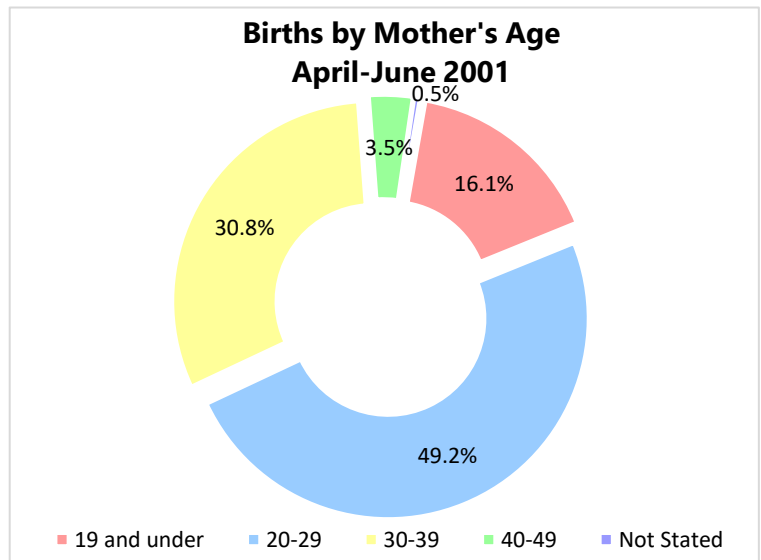

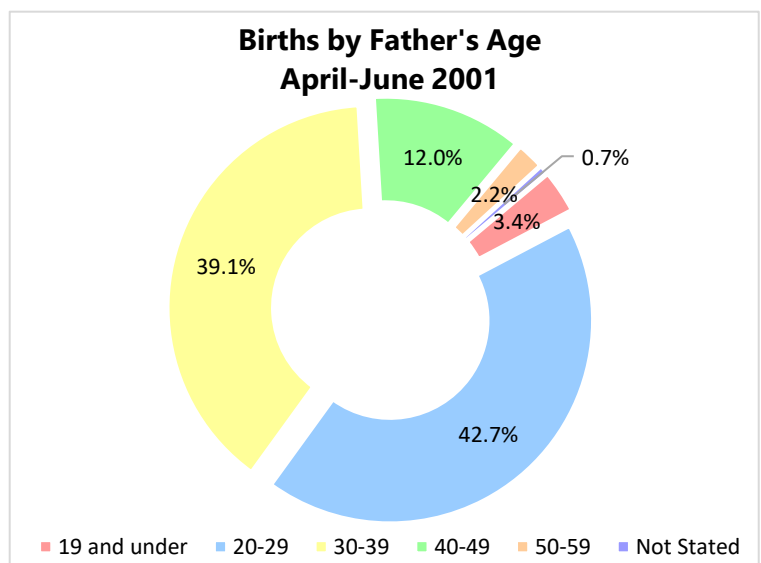
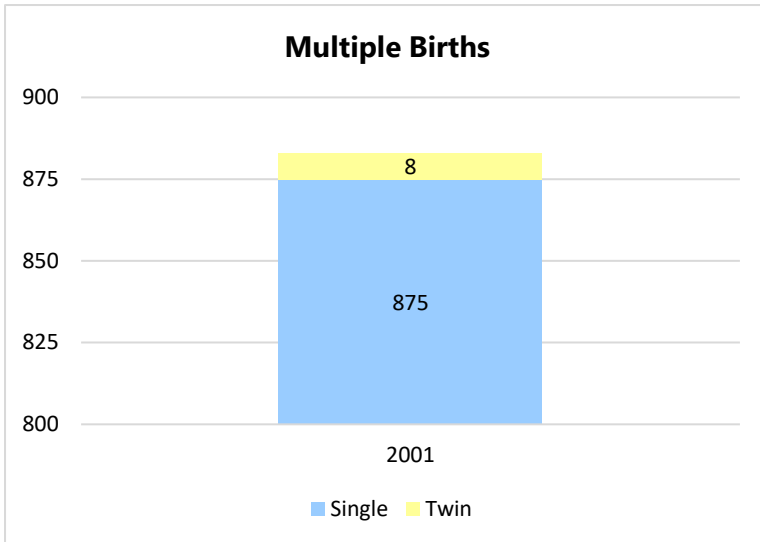

The number of single babies registered in the period under reviewed significantly outweighed those from a multiple birth. Single babies were recorded as **875**.

There were four sets of twins (**8 children**) born in this quarter of 2001.

Mothers from the parish of St. Michael produced the highest number of babies – **379 (42.9 percent)**, far surpassing Christ Church births of **135**, as the second highest recorded in the second quarter of 2001.

The number of babies for the quarter under review born in St. Lucy, St. Andrew and St. Joseph recorded the lowest birth counts of **20, 21** and **21** respectively. The proportion of births being **2.3, 2.4** and **2.4** percent correspondingly.

St. Philip and St. James babies were observed as **65** and **68** in turn.

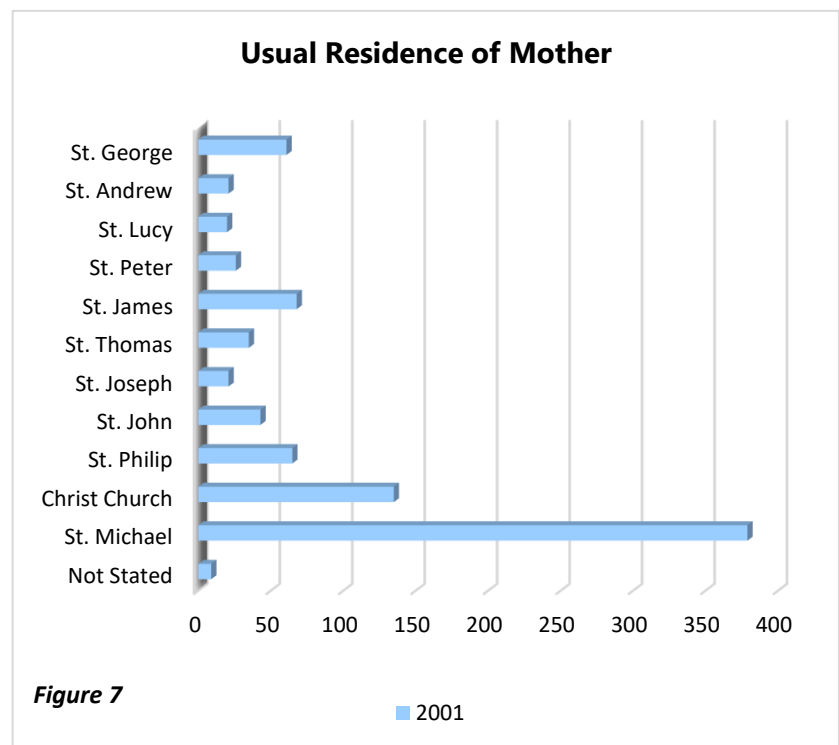

There were **5** still-born births recorded in the second quarter of 2001.

The average age of death during the period was **72.2** years.

The largest number was in the **80-89 years** age group with **29.9 percent**, followed by the **70-79** age group (**21.9 percent**).

In April to June 2001, the larger number of deaths was attributed to males – **289**, when compared to **267** females.

With regards to marital status in 2001, married persons accounted for **33.3 percent** of all deaths, followed by single which stood at **30.8 percent**.

**St. Michael** had the largest number of registered deaths – **235** for Q2 of 2001. However, the least number of deaths were recorded in **St. Joseph** – **12** and **St. Andrew** – **14** for the reference period.

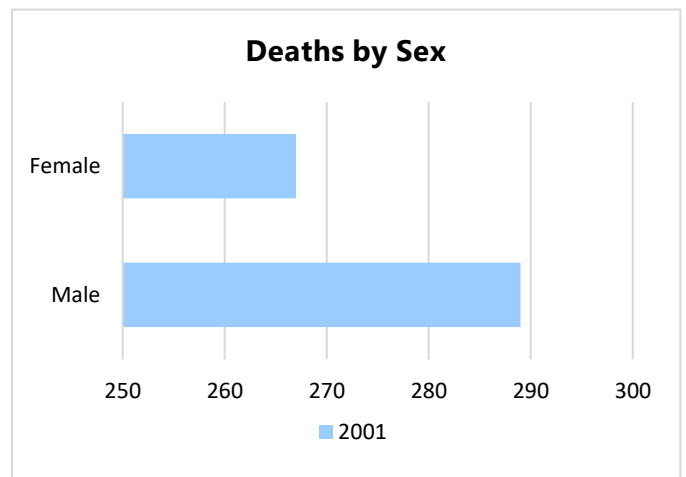

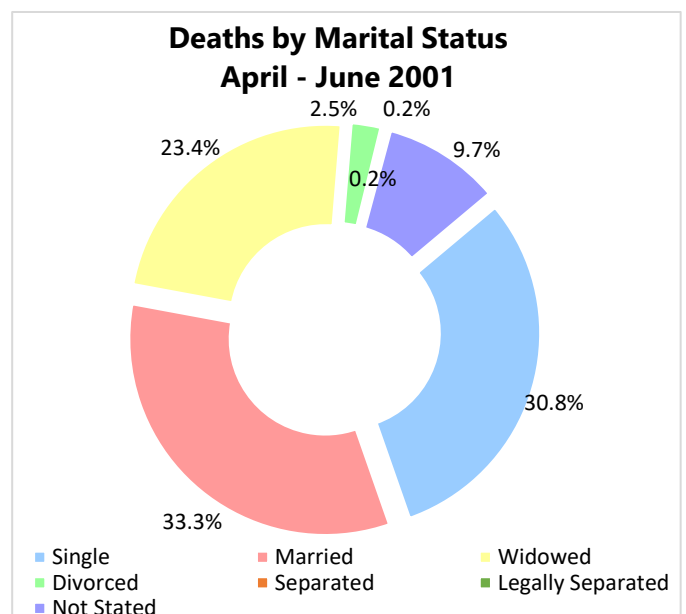
