

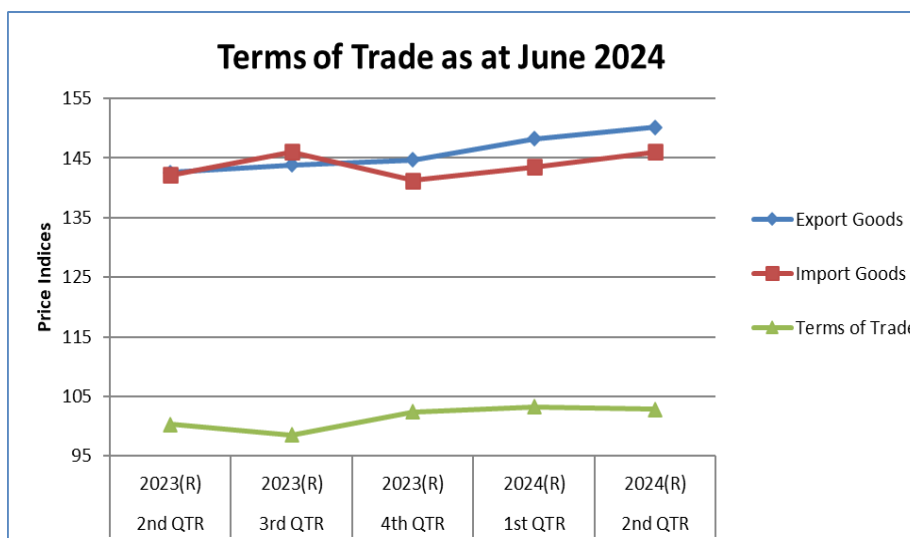
EXPORT-IMPORT PRICE INDEX

APRIL-JUNE 2024

The Export and Import Price Index (XMPI), along with the Retail Price Index and the Producer Price Index, is designed to capture the change in prices in Barbados. Foreign trade price indices allow policy makers to analyze the impact of international trade on growth and inflation in the domestic economy. The XMPI will be used to deflate the foreign trade component in the expenditure approach for calculating Gross Domestic Product at current prices thus deriving Gross Domestic Product at constant prices. The XMPI will also be a useful tool in tracking trade flows in real terms by breaking down changes in the value of traded goods and services into price changes, volume changes, or both. In addition, export and import price indices provide an early indicator of inflation pressures on the domestic economy as well as an input for a variety of other purposes including negotiations for trade agreements, analyzing the effects of exchange rates, and measuring competitiveness. This document specifically covers the movement of export and import prices within Barbados for the second quarter of 2024.

PERFORMANCE OF INDEX

- ❖ Import commodity prices increased by 1.8 percent for the period April to June 2024 and by 2.7 percent for the 12 month period ending June 2024.
- ❖ Export commodity prices increased by 1.3 percent for the quarter and by 5.3 percent for the 12 month period ending June 2024.
- ❖ The terms of trade, as measured by the ratio of export prices to import prices, decreased by 0.4 percent in the quarter and increased by 2.5 percent for the 12 months since June 2023.

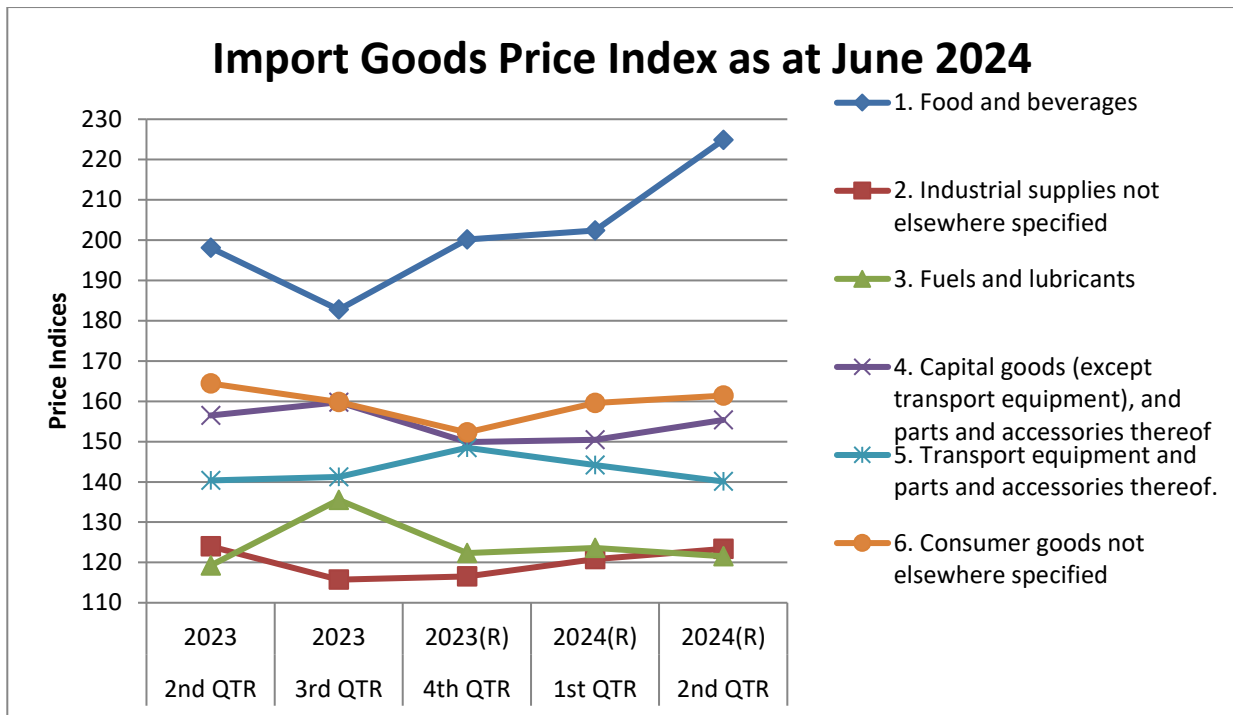

ANALYSIS OF EXPORT-IMPORT PRICE INDICES

Import Price Index for Goods

During the second quarter of 2024, Fuels and Lubricants prices declined by 1.7 percent while Consumer Goods increased by 1.2 percent. Food and Beverages prices increased by 11.1 percent while Transport Equipment prices decreased by 2.8 percent. In contrast, Capital Goods and Industrial Supplies both recorded increases of 3.3 percent and 2.1 percent respectively.

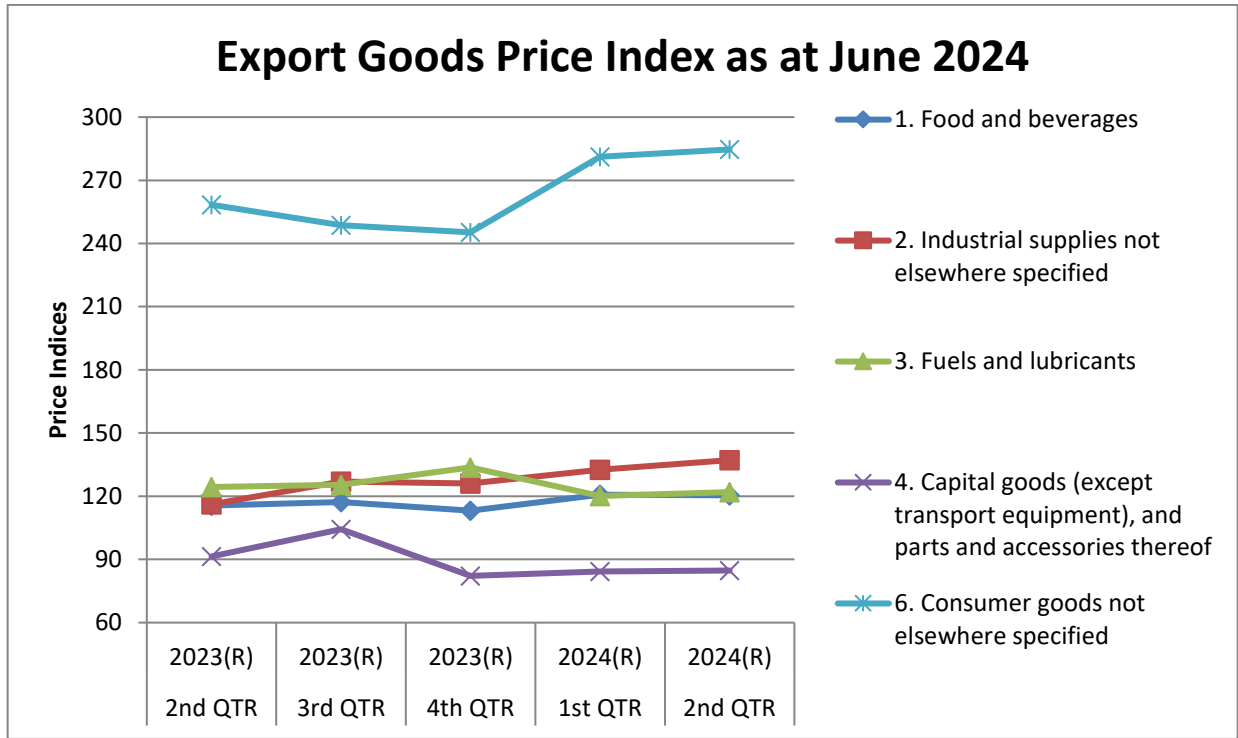
However, for the 12 month period ending June 2024, Fuels and Lubricants prices increased by 1.9 percent while Capital Goods decreased by 0.7 percent. Industrial Supplies recorded a decrease of 0.5 percent while Food and Beverages prices increased by 13.5 percent. In contrast, Transport Equipment and Consumer Goods prices recorded decreases of 0.2 percent and 1.8 percent respectively.



Export Price Index for Goods

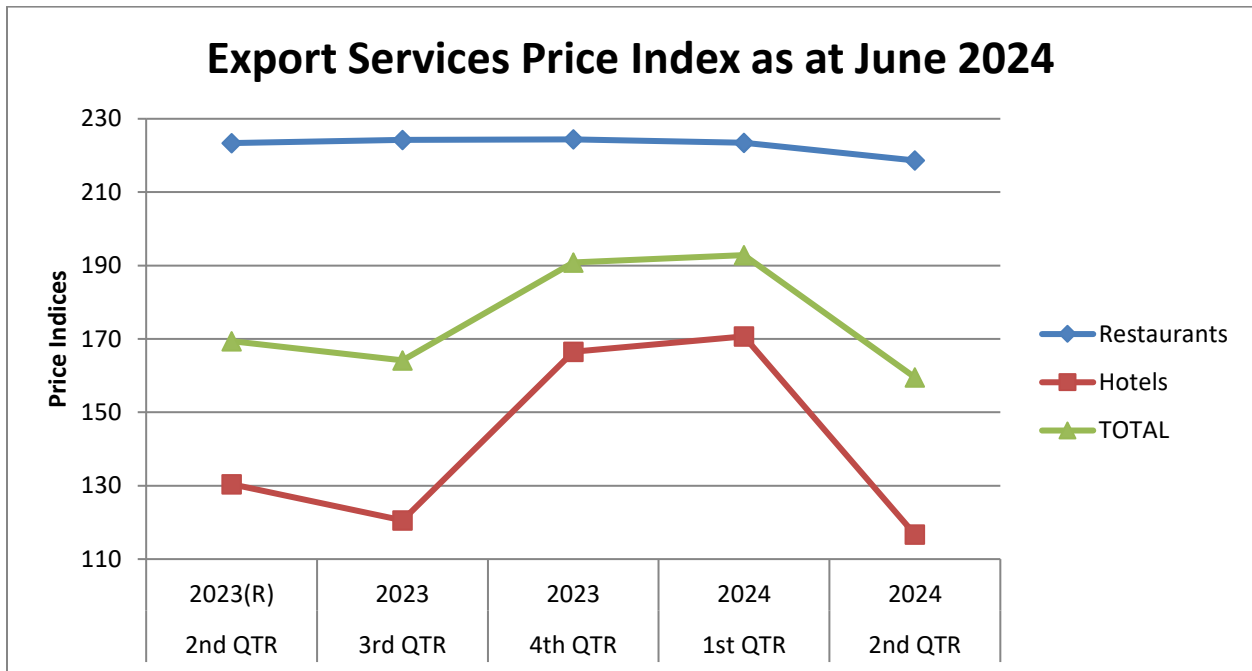
During the second quarter of 2024, both Fuels and Lubricants and Consumer Goods prices increased by 1.5 percent and by 1.2 percent respectively. Industrial Supplies prices increased by 3.5 percent while Food and Beverages prices decreased by 0.2 percent. Capital Goods prices increased by 0.4 percent.

However, for the 12 month period ending June 2024, Fuels and Lubricants prices declined by 1.9 percent while Consumer Goods prices increased by 10.2 percent. Capital Goods prices decreased by 7.4 percent. In contrast, Industrial Supplies and Foods and Beverages recorded increases of 18.0 percent and 4.3 percent respectively.



Export Price Index for Services

Export travel services decreased by 17.3 percent for the quarter as both restaurant and hotel prices decreased by 2.1 percent and 31.6 percent respectively. During the 12 month period ending June 2024, restaurant and hotel prices decreased by 2.1 percent and 10.5 percent respectively.
